
Assembly

NOTE: Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the allen driver (EE) to tighten. Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic caps (DD) after final assembly finished.




2 Attach the support rim to the table legs

- Attach the support rim (B) to the table legs (A) using M6 bolts (AA) and washers (CC).




NOTE: Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the allen driver (EE) to tighten. Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic caps (DD) after final assembly finished.



3 Turn the table up

- Turn the table right side up.
