

Heated Toilet Seat Installation Guide

1. What's Included

- 1 x Elongated heated toilet seat
- 2 x Mounting bolts
- 2 x Rubber washers
- 2 x Locking nuts
- 1 x Attached power cord

2. Tools Needed (Not Included)

- Adjustable wrench
- Screwdriver (if needed for existing seat removal)
- Clean cloth

3. Pre-Installation Preparation

1. Ensure the area around the toilet is clean and dry. Turn off power to any nearby electrical outlets as a safety precaution.
2. Remove the old toilet seat by unscrewing the mounting bolts from the bottom of the toilet bowl. Discard the old seat and hardware.
3. Wipe the top rim of the toilet bowl with a damp cloth to remove dust, dirt, or residue. Dry thoroughly before proceeding.

4. Step-by-Step Installation

1. Position the new heated toilet seat over the toilet bowl, aligning the mounting holes on the seat with the bolt holes on the bowl. Ensure the seat is oriented correctly (the front of the seat should match the front of the bowl).
2. Insert one rubber washer onto each mounting bolt. From the top of the seat, pass the bolts through the seat's mounting holes and into the toilet bowl's bolt holes.
3. From underneath the toilet bowl, thread a locking nut onto each bolt. Tighten the nuts by hand first to hold the seat in place. Then use an adjustable wrench to snug the nuts firmly—do not over-tighten, as this may crack the toilet bowl or seat.

4. Check the seat to ensure it is centered, stable, and does not wiggle. Adjust the position or tighten the nuts slightly if needed.

5. Power Connection & Initial Setup

1. Plug the seat's power cord into a standard grounded electrical outlet. Avoid using extension cords if possible; if necessary, use a grounded extension cord rated for at least 10A.
2. Once powered on, the seat will automatically start heating to 37°C. The real-time temperature will be displayed on the seat surface.
3. To adjust the temperature, press the side button to cycle through the three settings: 33°C → 36°C → 39°C. The display will update to show the selected temperature.

6. Key Features & Usage Notes

- **Slow Close:** Lower the seat and lid gently—they will close slowly on their own to prevent slamming.
- **Night Light:** The night light activates automatically in low-light conditions to provide subtle illumination without disturbing others.
- **Energy Efficiency:** The seat uses less than 0.5 kWh per day, even when running at the highest temperature continuously.

7. Safety Information

- Do not immerse the seat, power cord, or plug in water. Keep the seat dry to avoid electric shock.
- Unplug the seat before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or sharp tools on the seat surface, as they may damage the heating element or display.
- If the power cord is frayed or damaged, stop using the seat immediately and replace the cord with a manufacturer-approved part.
