

Bamboo Fence Assembly Instructions

Thank you for choosing our natural bamboo fence! Follow these simple steps to assemble it into a neat, attractive barrier that adds a touch of nature to your space.

Step 1: Unfold the Bamboo Fence to Form a Flat Surface

Take the folded bamboo fence out of the package and place it on a clean, flat ground (e.g., your garden, patio, or balcony).

Gently pull the two ends of the fence apart to unfold it fully.

Adjust the bamboo slats slightly to ensure they lie flat and aligned—no overlapping or twisting. This creates a smooth, even base for your fence.

Step 2: Secure the Fence with Additional String/Cord

Prepare a durable string or cord (jute, cotton, or garden twine is recommended, as it matches the natural style of bamboo).

Vertical Securing: For stability, tie the string around the bamboo slats at 30 – 40cm intervals along the height of the fence. Make sure the knots are tight but not too tight to damage the bamboo.

Horizontal Securing (Optional): If you need extra firmness (e.g., for windy areas), add 1 – 2 horizontal strings across the top and bottom of the fence. Tie each end of the horizontal string to nearby supports (like posts, railings, or stakes) to keep the fence in place.

Tips for a More Attractive Look

Keep the bamboo slats evenly spaced while securing—this enhances the natural, clean appearance of the fence.

Avoid using colored or thick synthetic strings, as they may distract from the bamboo's natural texture.

After assembly, wipe the bamboo surface with a dry cloth to remove any dust, keeping it looking fresh.
