

Instructions / Assembly

Thank you for choosing our Bulb Planter Tools Set. Please follow the steps below to assemble, use, and maintain your tool set safely and effectively.

- 1 Unpack all items from the package: long handle bulb planter, small bulb planter with depth markings, and gardening gloves.
- 2 Wear the included dirt-proof gloves to protect your hands during planting.
- 3 For the long handle bulb planter: Place the serrated blade on the ground where you want to plant. Step firmly on the wide foot plate to push the blade into the soil.
- 4 Twist the handle slightly and lift to remove a soil plug. The design automatically ejects the previous plug when making the next hole.
- 5 For the small bulb planter: Use it for more precise planting or smaller bulbs. Insert into the soil to the desired depth using the depth marks as a guide, then remove the soil plug.
- 6 Place the bulb (tulip, daffodil, lily, etc.) into the hole at the recommended depth.
- 7 Cover the bulb with soil and gently press to secure. Repeat as needed for rows or clusters of bulbs.
- 8 After use, clean soil from both planters and store them in a dry place to extend lifespan.
