



## Van Zyperden *Fritillaria* *Persica*



*Fritillaria persica*, commonly called Persian Lily, is a bulbous perennial known for its plum purple to gray green flowers in spring. Each stem holds up to 30 bell-shaped flowers atop a sturdy stem clad with greenish gray leaves. This species is native to Israel, Jordan, Iran, Syria and Turkey. Stunning specimen which is a must have for curb-appeal.



- Deer resistant, good cut flower and multiplies well
- Exotic looking hardy bulb

**Growing Instructions:** Plant one bulb per square foot immediately upon receipt.

**Care Tip:** Plant bulb at a 45 degree angle so that the water doesn't sit in the stem hole of the bulb.

**Exposure:** Prefers partial shade

**Height:** Grows 30" tall

**Spacing/Depth:** Plant 8" apart, 5-6" deep

**Blooms:** Mid Spring

**USDA Zones:** Hardy in USDA zones 4-8
