

Klean-Strip® 1-K Kerosene is refined to lower the sulfur content, improving air quality and extending wick life. This 1-K kerosene burns cleaner than 2-K kerosene. Klean-Strip® Kerosene meets ASTM 1-K Specifications and is suitable for all kerosene-burning heaters, lamps and stoves.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Always follow your kerosene appliance manufacturer's directions for fueling, ignition and all other activities associated with the use of the
appliance.
 Turn off kerosene appliance and allow to cool for at least 15 minutes before refueling.
 Move the appliance, or its portable tank,
outside the living area.
 Fill on a level surface, being careful to avoid spilling.
 Wipe off any excess fuel and close container and fuel tank.
 Move appliance to desired location to ignite.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, ventilated place. Close container and store upright after each use. Do not reuse this container. PROPER DISPOSAL: Dispose of in accordance with federal, state and local regulations. IMPORTANT: Carefully read all directions, notes and cautions prior to use. Only use this product as directed on the label. Do not use for any other purpose. Do not mix with any other product. Only transfer product from this container into the appliance. Do not store in or use from any other container. To be used as a fuel only in appliances specified as a kerosene fuel stove, lantern or heater. Do not use this fuel in gasoline or alcohol burning appliances. Do not fill while kerosene appliance is burning or any part is hot to touch. Install an appropriate carbon monoxide detector whenever combustible fuels are used indoors. Inadequate ventilation of portable kerosene heaters can cause fatal levels of carbon monoxide to accumulate.

DANGER! COMBUSTIBLE. KEEP AWAY FROM HEAT, SPARKS, FLAME AND ALL OTHER SOURCES OF IGNITION. Do not use in areas where vapors can accumulate and concentrate such as basements, bathrooms or small, enclosed areas. USE ONLY WITH ADEQUATE VENTILATION TO PREVENT BUILDUP OF VAPORS. Refuel outdoors in an open-air area. If strong odor is noticed or you experience slight dizziness, headache, nausea or eye-watering - STOP - ventilation is inadequate. Leave area immediately. DANGER!
