

Instructions & Assembly

Barnel Professional Pruners & Secateurs

INSTRUCTIONS: Open pruner handles all the way. Place cutting head on the subject green stem or branch, as far into the jaw as possible, and squeeze handles together. Do not exceed the specified maximum cutting capacity (branch diameter) for the pruner series. Do not force, twist, pull, or rip fibers. CENTER OILER BOLT (IF EQUIPPED): A self-oiling center bolt ensures continuous lubrication of the cutting head pivot point. Use B-OIL (sold separately) to fill the oiler bolt reservoir by depressing the ball bearing. TWO-POSITION LOCK (IF EQUIPPED): The two-position lock can be adjusted to prevent the pruner from reopening all the way. This is advantageous for smaller hands as well as for repeated cutting of smaller diameter targets.
