



### GENTLE DUSTING

Dust your Capiz furniture regularly with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth or a feather duster. This helps prevent the buildup of dirt and debris on the delicate shell surface.



# AVOID DIRECT SUNLIGHT

Position your Capiz furniture away from direct sunlight or use window coverings to shield it.

Prolonged exposure to sunlight can cause the shells to fade or become brittle over time.



When cleaning is necessary, use a solution of mild dish soap and lukewarm water. Dampen a soft cloth with the soapy water, wring it out well, and gently wipe the Capiz shells. Avoid soaking the shells or using excessive moisture, as this can damage them.



#### DRY THOROUGHLY

# PREVENT SCRATCHES
