



6. Store your CINEMOOD Storyteller in a room temperature, stable, and safe area.

LOW PICTURE BRIGHTNESS AND CONTRAST For the best viewing experience, watch your content in a dark or dimmed room on a white reflective surface. Turn off or dim the lights and direct the beam onto white surface. Adjust the picture using the focus buttons. If the picture is still blurred, the lens may need cleaning. Carefully clean the lens with a non-abrasive dry cloth.

Your device may havve run out of battery; try charging the CINEMOOD Storyteller again. If your CINEMOOD Storyteller is still experiencing problems after being fully charged,


