## Quick Start Guide

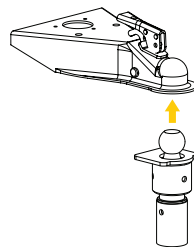


1.

Check trailer height and raise the trailer tongue to where the frame is about 16 inches off the ground to give adequate space to attach the dolly.

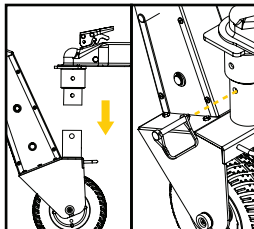
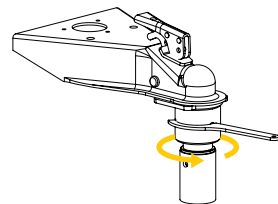
2.

Attach hitch ball w/ ball base to coupler.

Use spanner wrench and tighten that base!

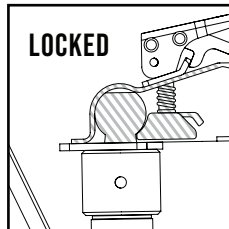


4.

Using your trailer jack, lower the hitch towards the unit's rotating coupler and attach rotation pin to secure.

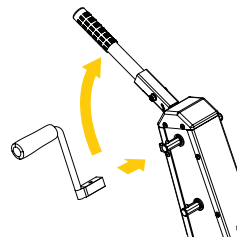
5.

Make sure the XL is securely tightened and not rocking.

Attach the crank handle, lift the steering handle to disengage brakes, and start moving!

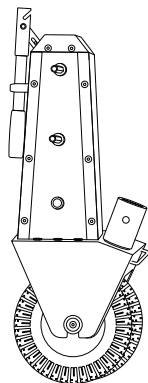

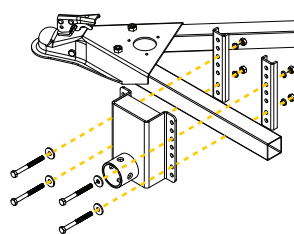


# TRAILER VALET XL W/ MOUNT BRACKET

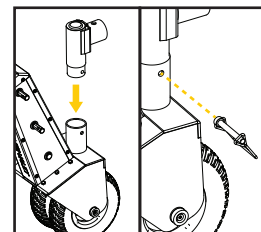
## Quick Start Guide



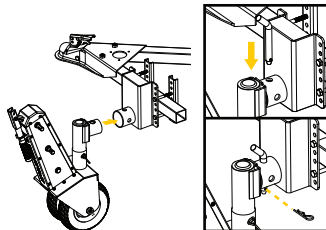
1. Check trailer height and raise the trailer tongue to where the frame is about 16 inches off the ground to give adequate space to attach the dolly.



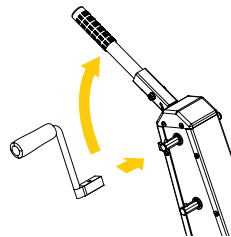
2. Install the XL Mount bracket to your trailer frame.



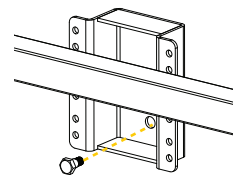
3. Attach mounting joint to the rotating coupler on the XL unit using the rotation pin.



4. Connect XL unit to Mount Bracket and secure with stop pin.



5. Attach the crank handle, lift the steering handle to disengage brakes, and start moving!



6. **OPTIONAL:** Lock with security bolt located in the back of the bracket to prevent removal.
