Furniture Care Guide

Upholstered Furniture

- Blot spills immediately with a soft, dry cloth
- Vacuum with an upholstery attachment to remove dust and dirt
- Spot clean with warm water and mild soap, then blot with a soft, dry cloth
- Limit excessive exposure to direct sunlight, heat and air conditioning
- Invest in arm covers to limit wear and tear in areas more prone to abrasion and dirt
- Use washable slipcovers to protect and increase the longevity of your upholstery
- Rearrange furniture on a regular basis so all pieces receive the same amount of use
- Lift furniture when rearranging rather than dragging pieces

Wood Furniture

- Dust regularly with a dry, lint-free cloth
- Blot spills immediately with a soft, dry cloth
- Avoid abrasive or harsh household cleaners
- Use coasters to protect surface against wet or hot items
- Limit excessive exposure to direct sunlight, heat and air conditioning
- Lift furniture when rearranging rather than dragging pieces
