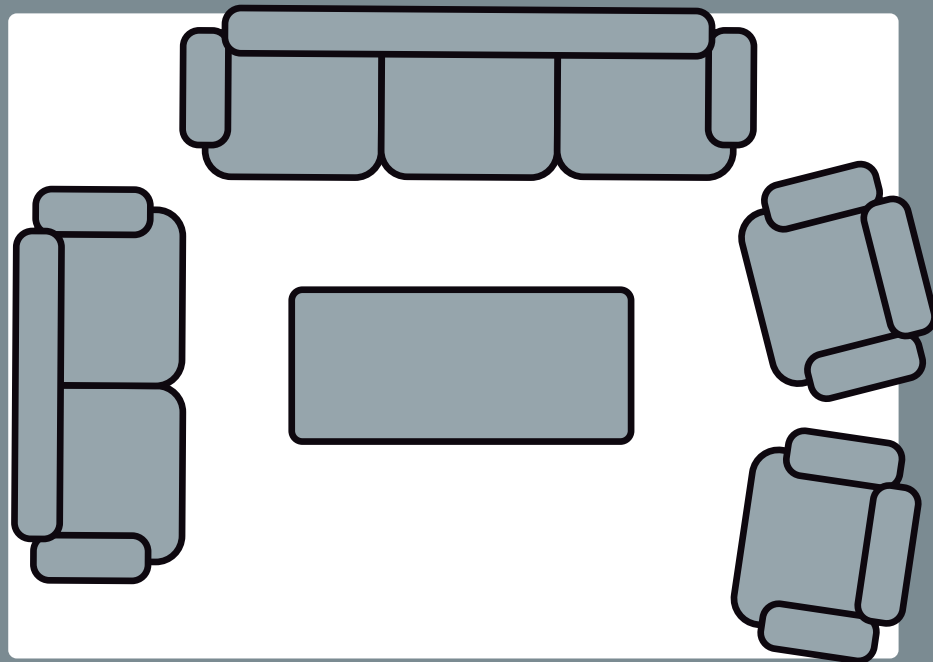


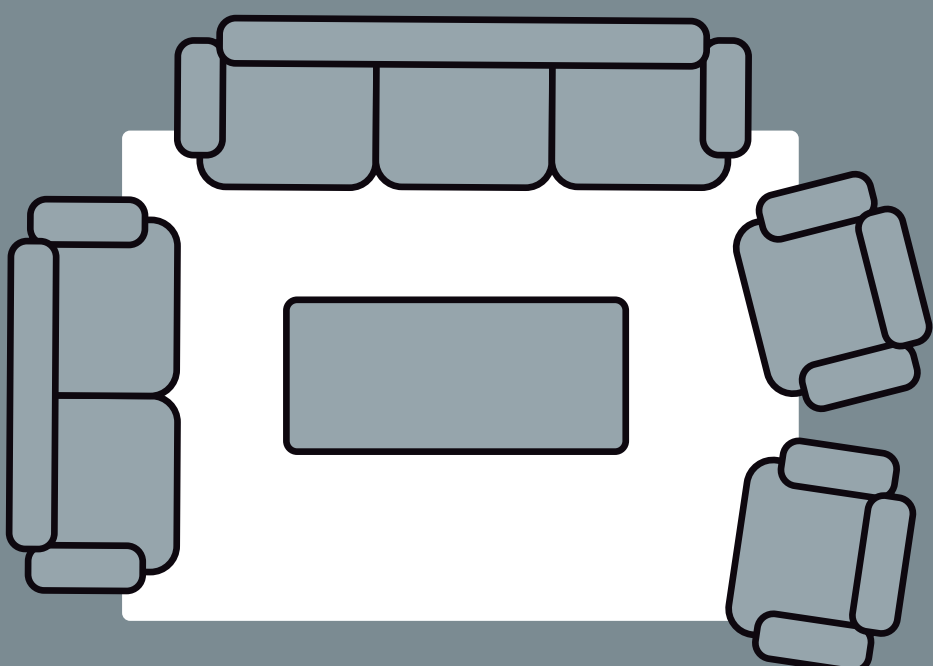
HOW TO CHOOSE THE RIGHT SIZE RUG FOR YOUR ROOM

LIVING ROOMS

The rug should be large enough to have the furniture - or at least the front two feet - on the rug, to help anchor the grouping.



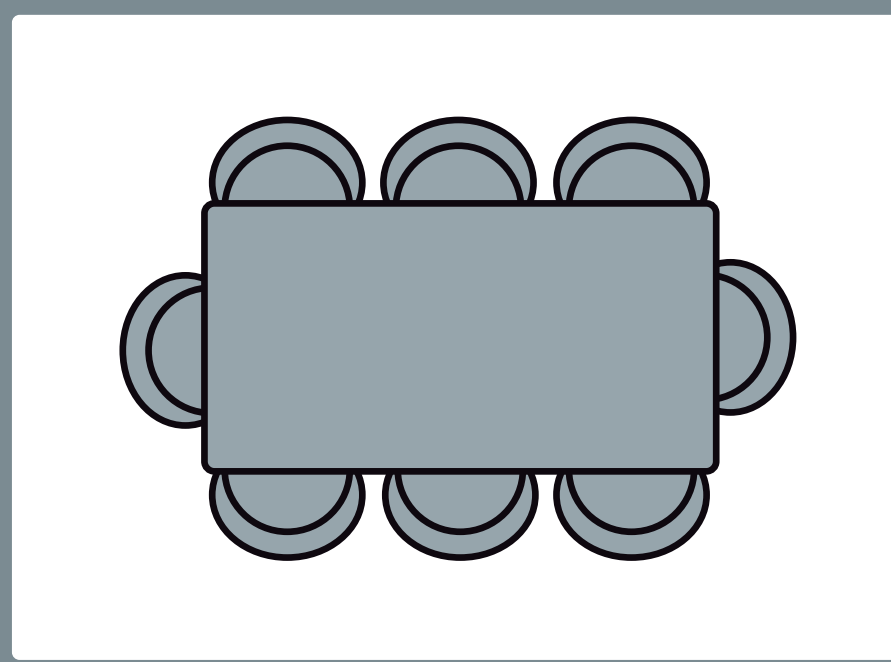
8' x 10'



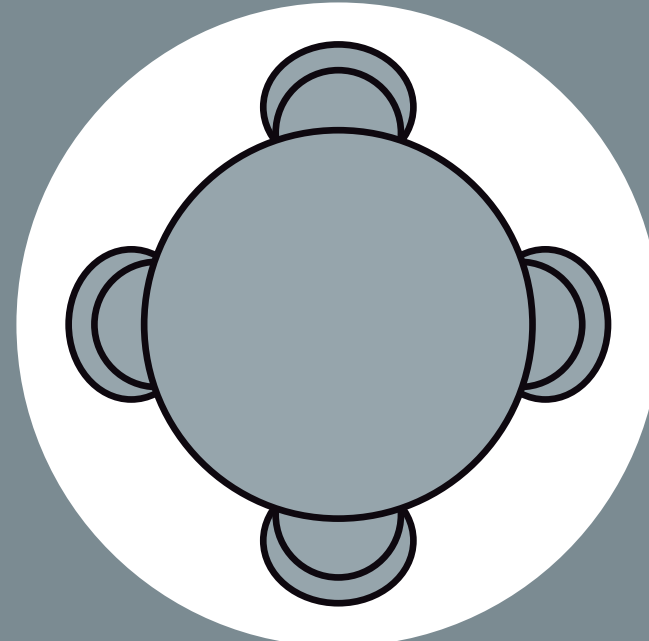
6' x 9'

DINING ROOMS

The rug should be at least 18" larger than the table on all sides. So when pulling a chair out to sit down, all 4 legs are still on the rug.



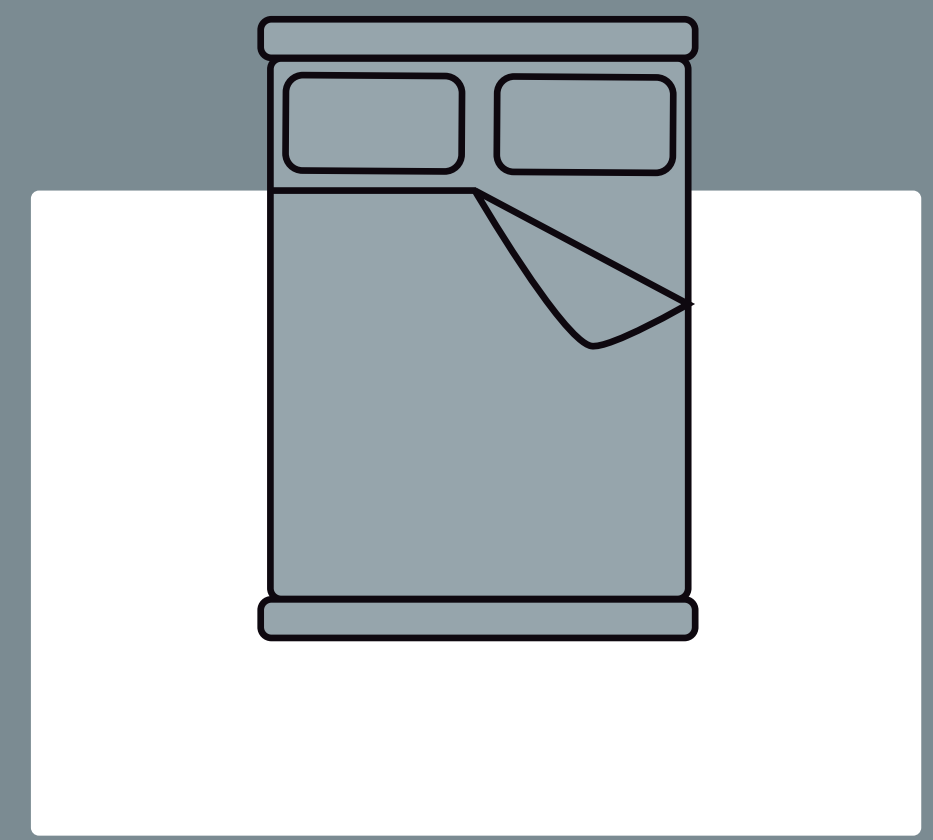
6' x 9' or 8' x 10'



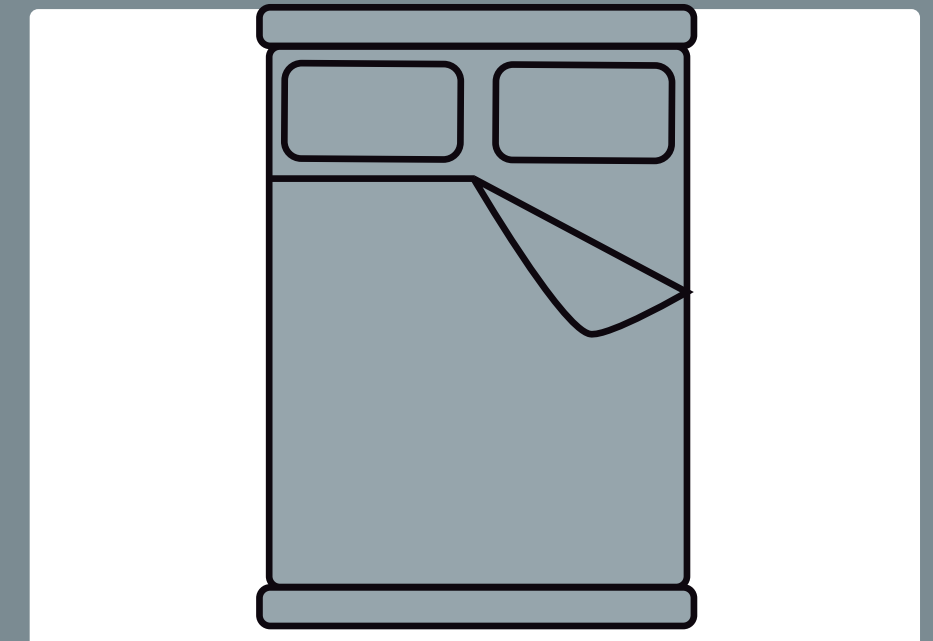
8' x 8'

BEDROOMS

The rug should be at least 18" larger than the bed on each side. So getting in and out of bed, your feet land on the rug.
