Sharpening cutlery


To maintain maximum performance, knives should be sharpened periodically.

- Pull knives through the built-in diamond sharpener with slight downward pressure until desired sharpness is achieved.
- The built-in sharpener can be cleaned and sharpening wheel can be replaced, if worn out.
