STAINS, WINE,
COFFEE, MILK,
BLOOD, SODA,
BEER, URINE, TEA,
JUICES. KOOL AID

LIQUID SPILLS-Use a water based soap **mixtu** that combines 1 tablespoon of a liquid **deter**gent such as Tide with 16 ounces of **lukewarm** water. Dampen the cleaning cloth in the **mix**ture and gently blot the soiled area. Avoid rubbing the affected area aggressively. **Rinse** the area with a clean, damp cloth to ensure th all of the soap residue has been removed.

## KETCHUP, SALSA, CHOCOLATE SYRUP/ CHOCOLATE, ICE CREAM, JELLY, CRAYOLA MAGIC MARKER, DIRT/MUD

NON-LIQUID SPILLS-The removal of dried non-liquid spills may require the use of a soft brush or butter knife on the affected area before following with any wet treatment.

After removal of the dried contaminants, repeat the

process of cleaning with the water-bæd soap mixture described in the liquid spills guideline above.

## **CLEANING**

Vacuum upholstery occasionally with soft brush attachment.
