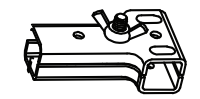

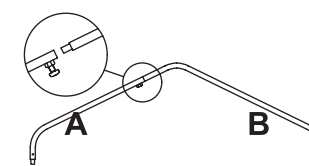

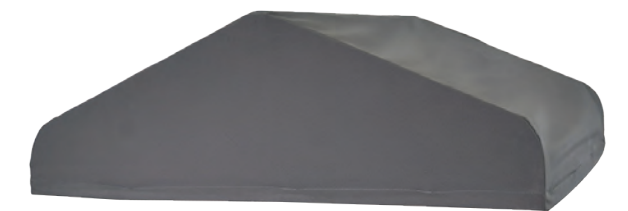

KENNEL ASSEMBLY

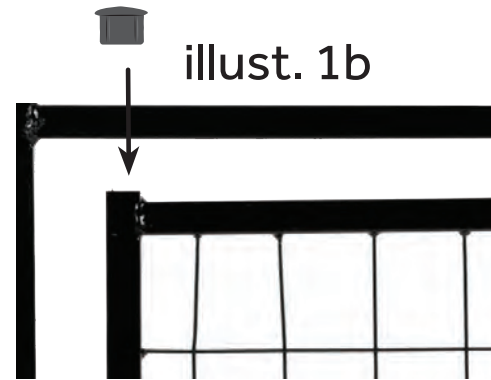
1) ATTACH GATE LATCH

to gate door at desired position (illustr. 1a). Insert Frame Caps into holes at the top of each panel and the gate door (illustr. 1b).

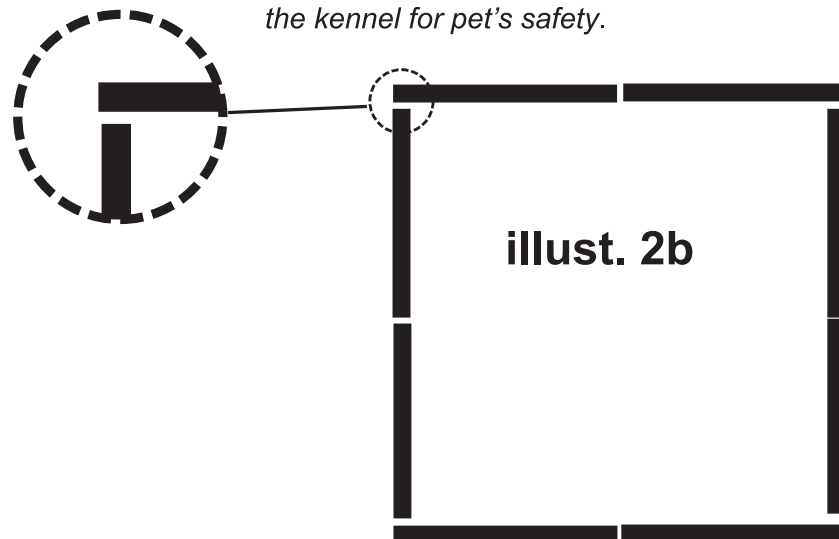

2) ASSEMBLE / CONNECT PANELS

Stand up 2 panels, forming a 90° angle. Apply **Clamps**, 6" from the top and 6" from the bottom. Do not overtighten. Repeat for the rest of the panels and gate until kennel is complete. Side panels are aligned on the **INSIDE** edge of the front and back panels. (illustr. 2b)

NOTE: Ensure that the wing nut is on the **outside** of the kennel for pet's safety.



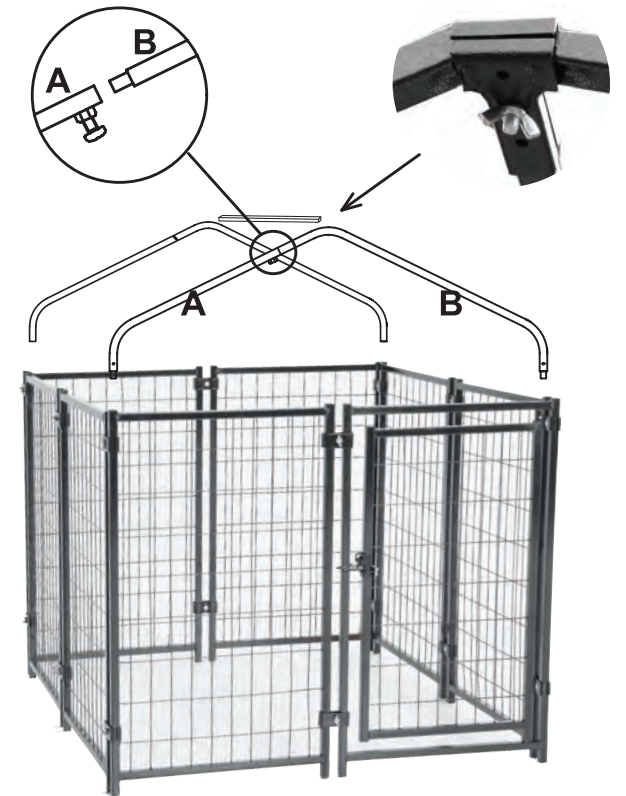
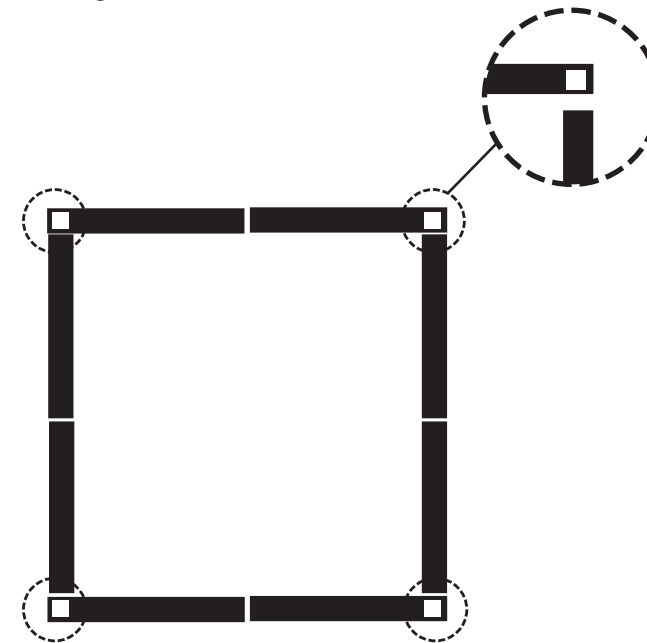
Warning: Roof is non-load bearing

Remove Canopy cover from frame before wind or snow

3) ROOF

(A) Insert **Roof Frame Peaks** into front and back panels of kennel. (B) Attach **Roof Frame Ridge Pole** to the center of each peak using the **"T" shaped clamps**, Do not overtighten.

NOTE: Wing nuts should be towards the **INSIDE** of the kennel, to prevent damage to the cover.



4) ATTACH COVER

Drape Canopy cover over kennel roof frame with the Lucky Dog® woven label on the exterior and attachment tabs on interior. Secure cover to kennel at all 4 corners first. Attach the tabs to the frame by pulling the long end of the tab around the outside of the top frame rail, looping it around while pulling snugly, and attaching it to small tab.
