LIVING ROOM

The rug should pull all
furniture together into
a single area.



B E D R O O M Leave at least 18"-24" of rug on either side of the bed.



DINING ROOM

Leave 18"-24" of rug

around all sides of the

seating area.

## RUG HEIGHT | HOW TO CHOOSE THE RIGHT PILE HEIGHT


FLAT

Typically, a .25" height. Durable construction and thin profile makes flat rugs ideal for heavily trafficked areas like entrances, hallways, living rooms and bedrooms. Allows clearance for doors.




LOW

Typically, a .25" - .33" height. Durable construction allows for even wear and easy maintenance. Good for heavily trafficked areas. Allows clearance for doors.



MEDIUM

Typically, a .5 - .75" height. Medium pile rugs offer underfoot comfort with the benefits of even wear and easy maintenance.



HIGH

Typically, a 1 - 2" height. The fluffy, thick pile is beloved by cold bare feet and adds soft luxury to a bathroom. A plush or shag rug adds bold character and a cozy feel to a bedroom or living room.
