

Acoustic Panel Installation Guide

1. Preparation

Measure your wall or ceiling to plan panel placement.

Gather tools: tape measure, level, pencil, screws, anchors, or strong double-sided tape.

Clean the installation area.

2. Placement

Focus on first reflection points where sound bounces first.

Distribute panels evenly for balanced sound absorption.

Avoid blocking vents or lights.

3. Installation Methods

A. Screws (for solid walls)

Mark panel corners on the wall.

Drill holes and insert anchors.

Hang panel and check level.

B. Double-sided Tape (for lightweight walls)

Clean the wall surface.

Apply tape to panel back.

Press firmly against wall.

C. Hook & Loop / Velcro (for easy removal)

Attach hooks or Velcro strips to wall and panel.

Align and secure panel.

4. Tips

Avoid direct sunlight or heat.

Leave small gaps for better absorption.

Stagger panels for optimal sound control.

5. Check

Ensure panels are level and secure.

Listen to confirm reduced echo and reverb.
