

Simple Mirror Setup & Safety Guide

For Your Safety:

Handle with care. Mirrors are fragile and can break if dropped or knocked over.

Place the mirror on a stable, level surface to prevent tipping.

Keep away from children and pets during setup.

1. Tabletop Mirrors

Simply place the mirror on a stable, flat surface like a desk, dresser, or counter.

Ensure the base is clean and dry for a secure fit.

2. Leaning / Floor Mirrors

Place the mirror on the floor against a wall.

Angle the mirror back slightly for stability.

Ensure the area is clear of foot traffic to avoid being knocked over.

3. Wall-Mounted Mirrors

Use appropriate wall anchors and screws for your wall type (drywall, concrete, etc.).

Secure the mounting hardware to the wall first, then hang the mirror.

General Tips:

Avoid hanging heavy mirrors on doors, as the movement can cause them to fall.

Do not overtighten screws on the mirror frame, as this may damage the glass.

Clean the glass with a soft, dry cloth.
