Thuja occidentalis 'Linesville'

Globe shaped arborvitae with very soft, feathery foliage. Does not have the typical arborvitae foliage, which may make it more attractive. Stays very compact and keeps its shape very nicely.

Hardiness Zones – 3-7

Sun Exposure/ Watering- Full sun to light shade, moderately drought tolerant once established

Mature Plant Size- 3x4' tall x 3x4' wide after 10 years. Very slow growing

Bloom Period - N/A

Growing Tips – relatively maintenance free, trim only if necessary

Uses Evergreen shrub border, pathways, sidewalks, specimens

Caring for Thuja occ. 'Linesville' — fertilize with an evergreen plant fertilizer in spring, protect from drying winds- especially in Winter. If trimming is necessary, only trim the new growth from the current season and remove any Winter dieback. Tolerant of urban pollution. Will need a slightly sheltered planting location. A thick mulch layer in Winter may be beneficial.

Pests & Problems of 'Linesville'

Tolerant of clay soils, black walnut roots, intolerant of dry conditions, bag worms and mealy bugs are possibilities for pests. Damage from ice and snow accumulations.
