

Acacia Wood Shower Stool Use and Care Manual

Product Overview

This shower stool features an acacia wood frame and seat, with stainless steel screws. It has a right-angle triangle shape, measuring 15.19"W x 14.1"H x 8.7"D, with a dual-layer design (top footrest and bottom storage compartment).

Usage Instructions

1. Place the stool on a flat, dry surface in the bathroom or desired area. Ensure it is stable and not wobbling before use.
2. The top layer serves as a footrest for shaving legs, nail trimming, lotion application, or toenail cutting. It can also hold small items like razors, nail polish, or foam jars.
3. The bottom storage compartment is suitable for storing towels, shampoo bottles, or other bathroom essentials.
4. Beyond bathroom use, the stool can function as a side table or plant stand for indoor and outdoor scenarios.
5. Do not exceed the stool's maximum weight capacity. Avoid standing or placing heavy objects on it to prevent damage.

Care Instructions

1. Wipe the acacia wood surface with a dry or slightly damp cloth regularly to remove moisture and dirt, especially after use in humid environments.
2. Keep the stool away from prolonged direct water immersion. Dry it promptly if splashed with large amounts of water to maintain wood integrity.
3. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or bleach, as they may damage the wood finish and stainless steel screws.
4. Inspect stainless steel screws periodically. Tighten them if loose to ensure stability and prevent rusting due to loose connections.
5. Store the stool in a well-ventilated area when not in use to reduce moisture accumulation and extend its service life.

Important Notes

This stool is designed for light-duty use only. Improper use or overloading may cause structural damage. The acacia wood and stainless steel construction ensures corrosion resistance, but proper care is essential for longevity.
