WHERE TO USE

For primed or painted Interior Ceilings.

PREPARATION

Remove loose paint, wash off any dirt and grease with detergent, remove mildew stains with a mildew stain removing product. Scuff sand glossy surfaces. Countersink nailheads, repair imperfections and sand smooth. Remove all dust with a damp cloth, allow to dry. Allow new stucco, plaster and masonry to cure for 30 days before priming.

PRIME

Use a product such as BEHR® KITCHEN, BATH & TRIM STAIN-BLOCKING PRIMER & SEALER NO. 75. On new drywall in low-moisture rooms, use a product such as BEHR DRYWALL PLUS PRIMER & SEALER NO. 73.

APPLICATION

Apply product when the surface and air temperatures are between 50–90°F (10–32°C). Stir paint occasionally. Intermix containers of same product to ensure color and sheen uniformity. Use a high quality 3/8-1/2" nap roller cover, nylon/polyester brush or an airless sprayer (.015"-.019" spray tip, 60 mesh filter). Do not thin if using a roller or brush; however, if using a sprayer and thinning is required, thin with water at a rate of no more than 1/2 pint per gallon. Certain colors may require more than one coat for complete hide. For popcorn style acoustic ceilings, use acoustic ceiling roller cover or airless sprayer (.015"-.019" spray tip, 60 mesh filter).
