Go Galley Assembly Instructions

Step 1: AS 1: Uncrate Go Galley



AS 1 - A

- Cut Shipping Bands.
- Lift up on Crate and Remove Plastic around Unit



AS 1 - B

- Unlatch Front Clasp.
- Carefully swing Right Hand Component open.
- Carefully remove all parts stored on this side of Unit.



AS 1 - C

- Carefully open Left Hand Component PART WAY.
- Very carefully, remove Grill Hood and all remaining parts inside Unit.

NOTE: Take Notice of which Component Wing is the Smoker and which is the Boiler.

Step 2: AS 2: Tilt Unit on Back.

CAUTION: Unit weighs over 300 pounds. DO NOT ATTEMPT ALONE.



AS 2 - A

- Close Components and Re-latch Front Clasp.
- Slide Unit to edge of Shiping pallet.
- Being careful to keep Unit on pallet, turn Unit up on it's Back as shown.



AS 2 - B

• Install Wheels.

NOTE: Be sure to install (2) Fixed Casters under base of Grill.



AS 2 –C

• Install (2) Swivel Casters under Wing Components (Boiler Wing and Smoker Wing).

NOTE: Be sure all Casters are fully seated into Caster receivers.



AS 2 –C

All wheels are now installed



CAUTION: Unit weighs over 300 pounds. DO NOT ATTEMT ALONE.

→ Also Remember – You are Now Setting Unit on Wheels. It Will Have a Tendency to Roll!



AS 3 - A


- Slide Unit to edge of pallet with wheels hanging over.
- VERY Carefully tilt forward and allow wheels to make controlled contact with ground.



AS 3 - B

• Slowly transition weight from pallet to wheels while keeping balance under complete control.

Step 4: AS 4: Install Lift Mechanism



AS 4 - A

• Press Down on Winch Power Switch.



AS 4 - B

• When you hear the Winch releasing cable, manually pull the Cable Loop from the rear of Unit until some 18 inches of cable is extended.



AS4-C

• See Pictured Lift Assembly.



AS4-D

• Attach Lift Assembly to back of Unit using (4) 3/8 by 4 inch Allen Head Cap Screws. (Use Allen wrench included)

NOTE: Be Sure to Tighten with Full Hand Pressure on the Provided Allen Wrench.



AS4-E

• Picture Shows Allen Head Cap Screw Being Tightened.

NOTE: Check Cap Screw Torque Prior to Every Transport.



AS4-F

Note: Lift Assembly should swing up and down freely,

Step 5: AS 5: Install Hitch Tongue



AS 5 - A

- Remove Rear Hitch Pin for Rear Lift Arm.
- Hold Hitch Tongue so Pin can be inserted through Rear Solid Hole. (Holding Front Lift Arm Up and clear is helpful.)



AS 5 - B

• Install Winch Cable Eye into welded clevis on Hitch Tongue using 3/8 Pin and Cotter Key.



AS 5 - C

- Remove Front Wrist Pin from Front Lift Arm.
- Hold Hitch Tongue so Pin can be inserted through Front Slotted Hole in Hitch Tongue.

• Picture of Complete Hitch





AS 6 – A

 Install Grill Heat Diffusers by inserting tabs into slots inside Grill Cavity



AS 6 – B

• Install Grill Heat Diffusers by inserting tabs into slots inside Grill Cavity

Step 7: AS 7: Install Grill Windscreens



AS7-A

 Install Rear Grill Wind Screen upright into Unit, using selftapping screws provided



AS7 - B

• Install Right Hand Grill Wind Screen in upright position using self-tapping screws



AS7-C


• Install Left Hand Grill Windscreen in upright position using self-tapping screws

NOTE: Fasten the corners of Side Windscreens to Rear Windscreen with Machine Screws.



AS 7 –D

• Install Front Grill Cook Grid Channel to Unit with selftapping screws





AS8-A

 Install Grill Hood Handle onto Grill Hood with ¼ Machine Screws



AS8-B

 Install Grill Hood Handle onto Grill Hood with ¼ Machine Screws



AS8-C

 Install Grill Hood onto Left Hand and Right Hand Grill Windscreens with Shouldered Screws.

Step 9: AS 9: Grill Items




AS9-A

• Install Warmer Rack by fitting turndown probes into predrilled holes in windscreens



AS9 - B

 Install Grill Cook Grids by sliding into Front Grill Cook Grid Channel





AS 10 - A

- Slide Grill Drip Pan directly under Burners and into channels on either end of Grill and attach with the two screws provided.
- Slide Collection Box into tracks under Drip Pan.

Step 11: AS 11: Doors under Grill



AS 11 – A

- Install both Right-Hand and Left-Hand doors by aligning hinge pins and sliding hinge down over pin.
- NOTE: Before Attaching Be sure Gas Hose cut out is located in lower inside corner and that Door opens Outward.





AS 11 – C

• Finished Door Assembly



AS 11 – D

 Attach Nylon LP Tank Strap to LP Tank at This Point

Step 12: AS 12: Smoker Inserts



AS 12 – A View of Smoker Chip Tray Rack (Pre- Assembled)



As 12 – B

 Place Smoker Chip Tray into Rack and set Chip Tray Top on Tray



AS 12 – C

- Slide Smoker Steam Water Pan in lowest Smoker Wall Bracket Slide.
- Slide (4) Smoker Cooking Racks into Smoker Wall Brackets
