

Landscape Edging Installation Guide

Step 1: Plan Your Layout

Decide where you want to place the edging. Mark the shape using a garden hose, string, or spray paint for curved or straight lines.

Step 2: Prepare the Ground

Clear the area of grass, rocks, and debris. For best results, lightly water the soil to make installation easier.

Step 3: Connect the Edging Pieces

Align the edging sections and use the included clips to securely fasten them together. Make sure the connections are tight.

Step 4: Install the Edging

Wear gloves for safety. Press or lightly hammer the edging into the ground along your marked line. Use the built-in spikes to anchor firmly.

Step 5: Adjust and Secure

Make any necessary bends to fit curves. Ensure the top of the edging is even and aligned. Add soil or mulch to secure it in place.

Step 6: Final Touches

Double-check all sections are stable. Clean up any remaining debris and enjoy a clean, defined outdoor space!
