Worm Farming FAQs

1. How many Worms do I need for Each Product:

Worm Feast: 500 WormsWorm Café: 1000 WormsCan O Worms: 1000 worms

2. What Type of Worms should I use:

- Composting Worms/ Red Wrigglers/ Night Crawlers

3. Can I use the worms from my Garden?

- No, that's because they are not Composting Worms – they will not enjoy eating the food.

4. Will my worm survive in the Winter:

- The worms like plants will close up and die off over winter, but their eggs will survive. Each egg has 5-12 baby worms that will hatch in spring.
- You can more your worm farm indoors (Basement/ Laundry room)

5. Can the Worm Café/ Can O Worms function inside the house?

 Yes! Our worm bins have been designed to live indoors during winter – try moving into your basement/ Laundry room

6. Does it smell!?

 No, if you are constantly adding food and aerating a worm farm it should smell like rich dirt.

7. How long will it take for the food to break down in the Worm Bins?

- For Worm Bins 4-6 months
- For the Worm Feast, immediately the worms are doing the work by coming out of the holes of the product

8. What happens is my worm bins does start to smell?

- Sprinkle the Worm conditioner once a week, mix this into the bin – this will help balance out the acidity in the worm bin. Perfect solution for customers.

9. Will the Worm Bins attract rodents?

No, if you aerate the worm bin weekly by mixing with a garden fork it will not attract animals. If you have rodent issue though, it may be best to keep your worm bin inside.
