







- 1 Turning off the water supply

2 Removing the old flush valve

- Disconnect the water supply line (1) from the ballcock shank (2) beneath the tank. Disconnect the tank from the bowl.
- Remove the old flush valve from the tank.



${f 3}$ Installing the new flush valve

- Install the shank gasket (1) and insert the new flush valve (A).
- Attach the shank nut (2).
- Install the tank-to-bowl gasket and place the tank on the bowl.
- Reconnect the washers and nuts that attach the tank to the bowl.
- Reconnect the refill tube (3) and tank lever (4) to the flush valve (A).
- Test flush and check connections.
- Adjust the water level if necessary.
