

Reed Fence Installation Guide

Tools & Materials Needed

- 1 Reed Fence Panel
 - Zip Ties
 - Scissors or garden shears
 - Measuring tape
 - Work gloves
 - Optional: glue for sealing cut edges
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Step 1: Measure Your Space

Use a measuring tape to determine the length and height of the area you wish to cover. Ensure the fence panel will fit properly before installation.

Step 2: Prepare the Surface

Clean and inspect the surface (fence, railing, or wall) where you plan to attach the reed fence. Make sure it's dry and stable for secure fastening.

Step 3: Position the Fence

Unroll the reed fence and position it against your chosen surface. Align the top edge evenly along your structure for a straight and clean appearance.

Step 4: Secure with Zip Ties

Use the provided zip ties to fasten the fence every 12-18 inches along the top, middle, and bottom. Pull ties tight for a snug fit but avoid over-tightening.

Step 5: Trim & Finish (Optional)

To customize the size, trim the reed using shears. Apply glue to the area before cutting to prevent fraying. Let the glue dry before trimming.

Care & Maintenance

Inspect regularly for loose ties or damage. Clean with a soft brush and water if needed. During extreme weather, consider removing or reinforcing the fence.
