Installation


Installing the stem

- With reference to the line drawing, install the rod (KK) to the fixture body (D) and twist clockwise to secure in place.
- Place the wood frame (B) over the protruding nipple of the rod (KK) and install the bottom hanging stem (JJ) to the rod (KK), until snug.
- Repeat the above step, and install the upper hanging stem (HH) to the canopy (A).
- Adjust the chain (II) to your desired length by removing the links if needed. You may need to use pliers (not included) to open the chain links (GG). If so, put a cloth over the chain to protect the finish from the pliers.
- Connect the chain (II) to the loop on the top of the bottom hanging stem (JJ) and the loop of the upper hanging stem (HH) using the chain links (GG).
- Pull the power cord up through the rod (KK), bottom hanging stem (JJ), fixture chain (II), upper hanging stem (HH) and canopy (A).




2 Installing the safety cable


Using a screwdriver, attach the safety cable (1) with the wood screw (included) in the eyelet grommet into the junction box (not included).
 See the illustration below.



3 Installing the mounting plate



- Remove the mounting plate (FF) from the canopy (A) by loosening the two ball nuts (BB) on the canopy (A).
- Attach the mounting plate (FF) to the junction box with the outlet box screw (CC).






4 Connecting the wires



NOTE: Always use wire nuts (EE) or marrettes (included) to connect wires and push all excess wires and connections back into junction box.


- Push all slack fixture wire through the canopy (A) and into the outlet box. Trim the excess fixture wire, leaving a minimum of 6 in. hanging out of the outlet box.
- Connect the ground wire from the branch circuit to the ground screw (DD) on the mounting plate (FF)
- Connect the chandelier cable as follows:






5 Installing the fixture body

 Install the canopy (A) to the mounting plate (FF) by securing the two ball nuts (BB) to the two screws (AA).



6 Installing the glass shade


- Remove the socket ring (MM) and glass holder (LL) from the socket of the fixture body (D) by hand.
- Place the glass shade (C) and glass holder (LL) on the socket. Secure with the socket ring (MM) by using the socket ring tool (NN). Do not overtighten.
- Repeat for the other glass shades (C).



Installation (continued)

7 Installing the bulbs

 Install 60W max.Type G16.5 bulbs (not included) in each socket of the fixture body.



Care and Cleaning

 Clean the light fixture carefully with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use any cleaners with chemicals, solvents, or harsh abrasives.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
□ The bulb will not light.	□ The bulb is burned out.	□ Replace the light bulb.
	□ The power is off.	□ Ensure that the power supply is turned on.
	□ The circuit breaker is off.	☐ Ensure that the circuit breaker is set to the ON position.
☐ The fuse blows or the circuit breaker trips when the light is turned on.	□ There are too many items on one circuit.	□ Unplug the other items on the circuit. □ Contact a qualified electrician or call the Customer Service Team at 1-800-986-3460.
