While fiberglass doors are weather-resistant, long-lasting, and low maintenance, it's important to maintain the appearance and function of your door.

CARING FOR YOUR FIBERGLASS DOOR

Without regular cleaning, dirt and dust can build up over time and will be very difficult to remove. Clean your door 1-2 times per year to prevent dirt buildup. Mild soap and water are usually sufficient. Avoid abrasive cleaners, chemicals, or scouring pads as they can damage the surface and/or stain of your door.

Do not power wash fiberglass doors, as it can damage and wear down the wood-like surface of your door. For glass windows, use a glass cleaner specifically designed for glass surfaces.

Lubricate hinges and locks with a silicone-based lubricant, such as WD-40, to prevent squeaking or sticking.

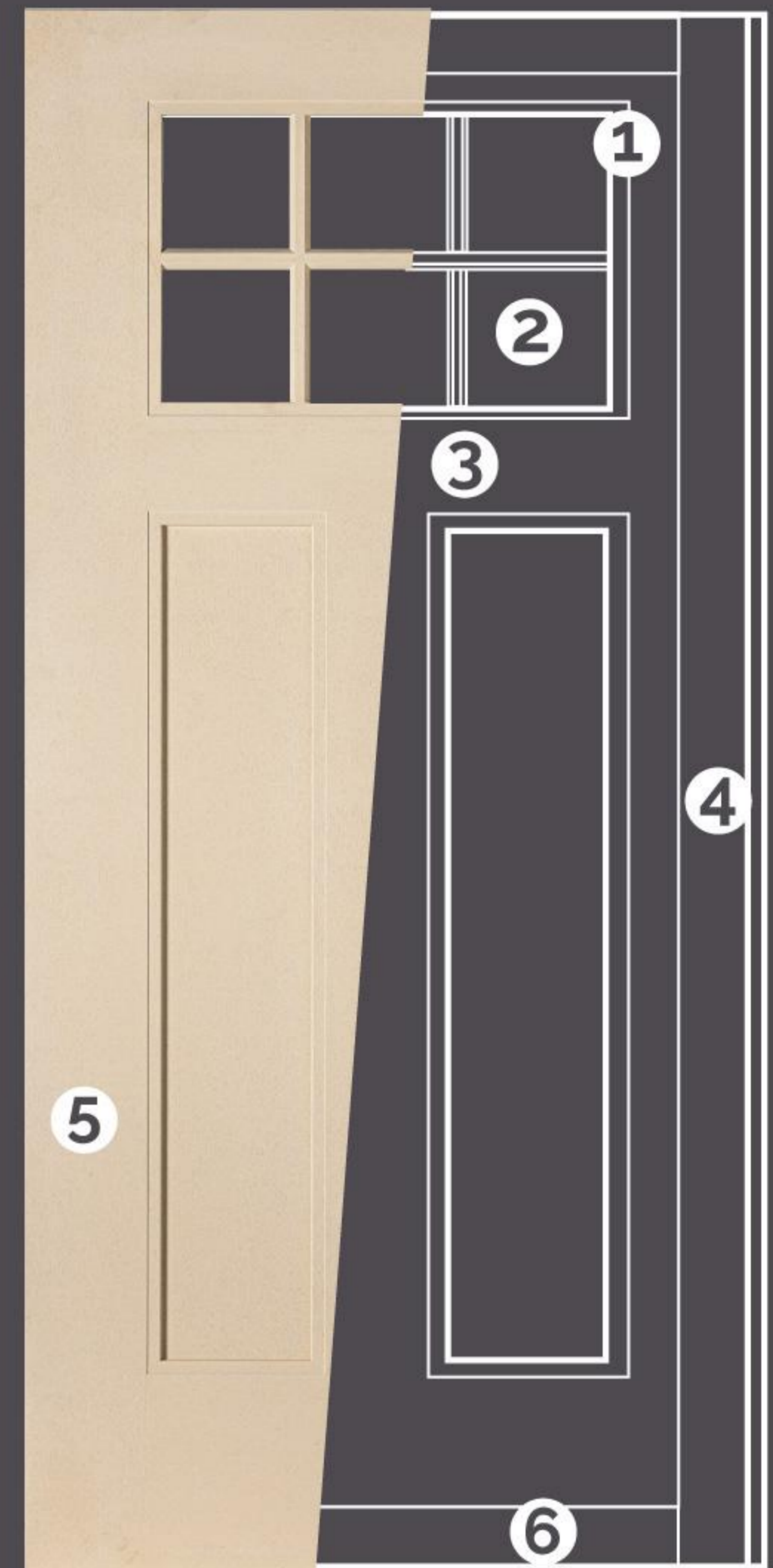
INSTALLING YOUR DOOR AFTER CONSTRUCTION
