

Outdoor Aluminum Patio Furniture Care & Maintenance Guide

1. Regular Cleaning

Wipe frames and cushions with a soft cloth, mild soap, and warm water. Rinse thoroughly and air dry completely. Avoid abrasive cleaners, bleach, or harsh chemicals that can damage the finish and fabric.

2. Frame Care

Inspect bolts and screws monthly, tighten as needed to maintain stability. For stubborn dirt, use a soft-bristled brush. The powder-coated aluminum frame resists rust, but avoid prolonged exposure to saltwater (for coastal areas, rinse weekly with fresh water).

3. Cushion Care

Remove cushions during heavy rain, snow, or long-term storage to prevent mold and mildew. Spot clean stains immediately with mild detergent. Air dry fully before placing back on furniture. Store cushions in a dry, cool area when not in use.

4. Seasonal Storage

When not in use (e.g., winter), clean and dry all parts thoroughly. Store furniture in a covered, dry space, or use a weatherproof furniture cover to protect from UV rays and extreme weather.

5. Pro Tips

- Avoid dragging furniture to prevent frame and floor damage.
- Keep furniture away from direct heat sources (e.g., fire pits) to avoid fabric melting or frame warping.
- For long-lasting color, limit prolonged direct sunlight exposure when possible.
