

Installation Guide – Manual Half-Moon Edger

Product Overview

- Manual half-moon lawn edger with saw-tooth serrated blade.
- Carbon steel blade, corrosion-resistant and durable.
- 39-inch long handle with ergonomic grip and wide pedal design for comfort.
- Ideal for edging sidewalks, driveways, patios, and garden beds.

What's Included

- Manual edger tool (assembled)

Before You Begin

- Wear protective footwear and gloves when using.
- Inspect blade to ensure sharpness and free of debris.
- Check handle and pedal are securely attached.

Installation & Setup

- No assembly required; product is ready to use.
- If handle is detachable, insert into the socket and tighten any provided fasteners.

How to Use

- Place the saw-tooth blade edge at the boundary where trimming is needed.
- Step firmly on the pedal with your foot to drive blade into the soil.
- Rock the handle gently forward and backward to cut through turf or roots.
- Lift and remove sod to create a clean, defined edge.
- Repeat process along the desired edging path.

Care & Maintenance

- Clean off soil and debris from the blade after each use.
- Wipe blade dry to prevent rust; apply light oil for extended protection.

- Store in a dry place away from moisture to preserve steel.
- Sharpen serrated edge as needed with a file or grinder.
- Do not use as a prying tool to avoid bending or damage.

Troubleshooting

- Blade not penetrating → sharpen blade; apply more even foot pressure.
- Pedal bending → ensure using within intended soil conditions (avoid rocky soil).
- Handle loosens → tighten fasteners or inspect for wear.
