

CLEAR₂O Quick Start Card



Step 1 Identify Your Faucet

Identify and remove your faucet's aerator. If your faucet has an aerator, unscrew it as shown below in figure A1 and A2 (Your aerator may look different)

INSIDE THREAD

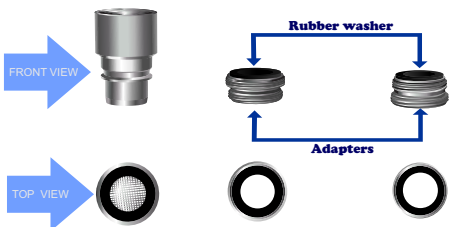


Important: The aerator has a rubber washer that get stuck to the metal faucet. Be sure to remove rubber washer from the faucet.

Step 2

Your aerator installation kit includes:

- Clear₂O aerator
- Two different sized adapters each with a rubber washer.

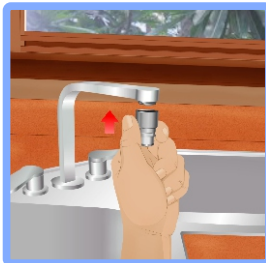


Step 3 Procedure

Install CLEAR₂O aerator to your faucet.

Note: You will only need to use the CLEAR₂O aerator for this procedure.

Faucet with Outside Rim



Install aerator with adapter with thread inside



Make sure the adapter has the rubber washer in place. If not, insert rubber washer into adapter.

Once you have the adapter that fits onto your faucet, screw onto faucet.

Tighten adapter in place.

Once adapter is secure, screw wide end of the CLEAR₂O aerator onto adapter with permanent rubber washer in place.

Never remove the rubber washers from the CLEAR₂O aerator.

Step 4 Ready to Attach Connector to Faucet



Grip connector with one hand and with free hand, push down outer ring



Keeping outer ring in the down position, place connector under the faucet and push it up onto the faucet to fit securely in place.

Important: To avoid damage to the faucet connector, you must push down the outer ring before pushing up the connector onto the faucet.

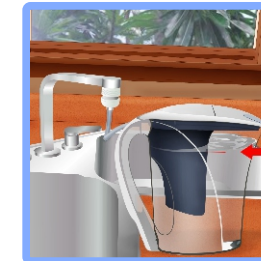
Step 5 Ready for Filtered Water



Turn faucet to cold water.

Important: You must use municipally treated /private well, portable water.

Never use hot water (above 85° F)



Open the faucet enough so that water flows through the hose.

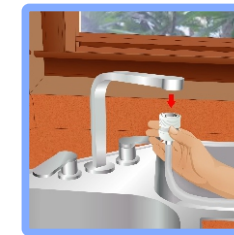
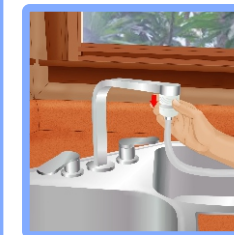
Important: To avoid overflow, do not use too much water pressure.

Fill the pitcher to the MAX line. Do not overfill.

Discard the first 3 pitchers of filtered water to flush the system.

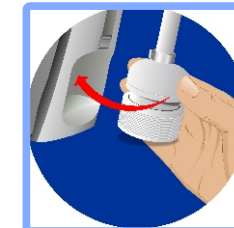
Replace filter

Step 6



Once the pitcher is filled with desired amount of water, again push down outer ring and then pull down connector to disconnect from the faucet.

Wipe the connect to dry.



When finished, insert quick-connect house and connector into storage compartment.

Keep new faucet adapter attached in place.

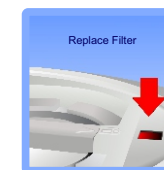
Replacing the filter



Good for 40 Gallons



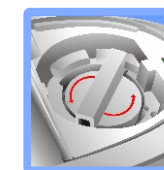
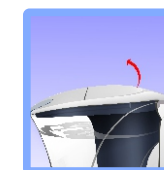

Replace Filter

Your CLEAR₂O pitcher has an intelligent Filter indicator built into the filter cover that automatically activates to the flow meter indicator and resets it every time you install a new filter.

Making it easy to know exactly when to replace the filter.



To remove the filter, lift the filter, lift the lid and open the lid.

Turn the bar on the filter counter clockwise to the unlocked position. Keep turning the bar until filter released.

Pull out the filter and discard.
