

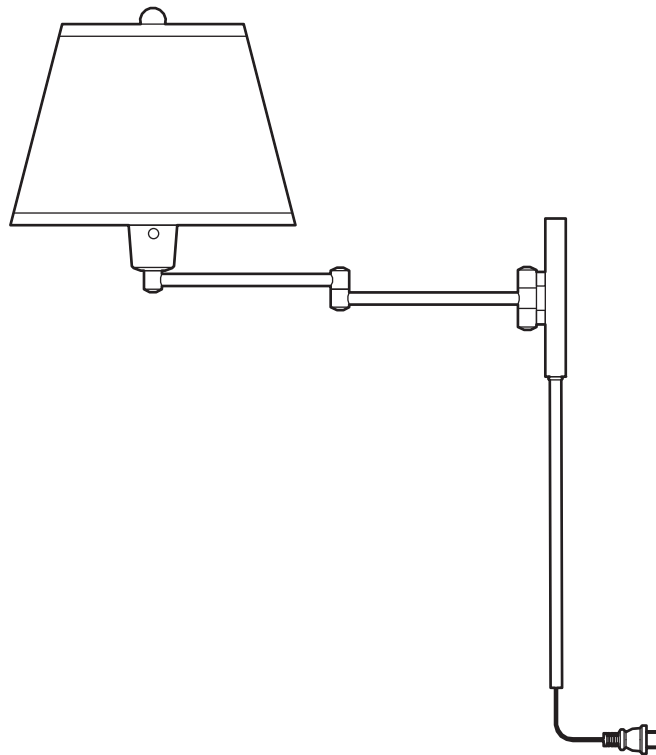

# Warranty

## 1-YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

### WHAT IS COVERED

The manufacturer warrants this lighting fixture to be free from defects in the materials and workmanship for a period of one (1) year from date of purchase. This warranty applies only to the original consumer purchaser and only to products used in normal use. If this product is found to be defective, the manufacturer's only obligation, and your exclusive remedy, is the repair or replacement of the product at the manufacturer's discretion, provided that the product has not been damaged through misuse, abuse, accident, modifications, alterations, neglect or mishandling. This warranty shall not apply to any product that is found to have been improperly installed, assembled, or used in any way not in accordance with the instructions supplied with the product. This warranty shall not apply to a failure of the product as a result of an accident, misuse, abuse, negligence, alteration, faulty installation, or any other failure not relating to faulty material or workmanship.

### WHAT IS NOT COVERED

This warranty shall not apply to the finish on any portion of the product due to weathering, as this is considered normal wear. The manufacturer does not warrant and specifically disclaims any warranty, whether expressed or implied, other than the warranty contained herein. The manufacturer specifically disclaims any liability and shall not be liable for any consequential or incidental loss or damage, including but not limited to, any labor or expense costs involved in the replacement or repair of the product.

Keep your receipt and these instructions for proof of purchase.

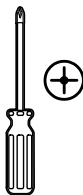

# Assembly

## 1 Assembling the cord cover

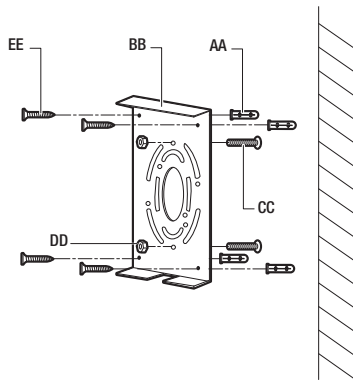
- Carefully unpack the lamp and lay out all parts on a clean surface.
- Insert the cord cover (G) into the hole in the bottom of the backplate (F) and secure with the cap (GG).



# Installation

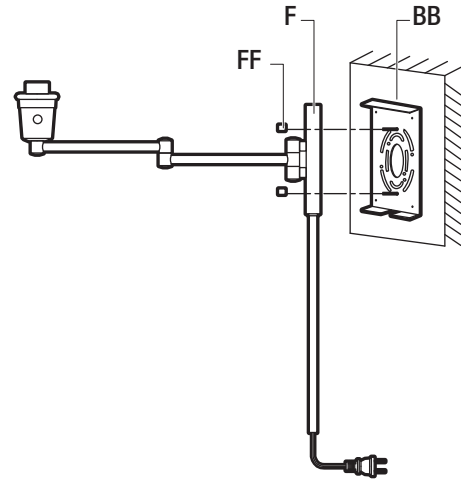
## 1 Installing the mounting plate

- Screw two mounting screws (CC) into the holes in the mounting plate (BB). Ensure they align with the holes in the backplate (F) portion of the lamp.
- Secure the mounting screws (CC) with the small nuts (DD).
- Position the lamp on the wall at the desired location and mark the place for the wood screws (EE) to be installed.
- If installing into dry wall, drill pilot holes on the marked spots and insert plastic anchors (AA). If installing to wood studs, skip this step.
- Attach the mounting plate (BB) to the wall using the screws (EE).



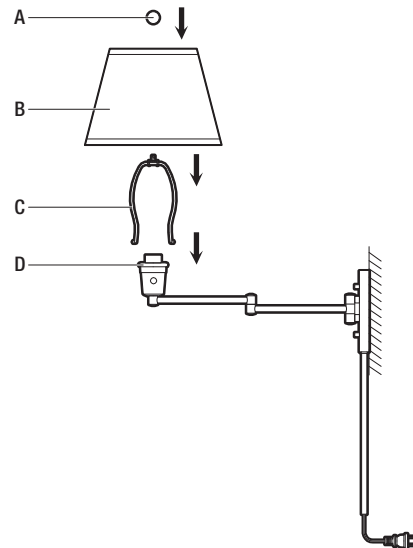
## 2 Hanging the lamp

- Raise the lamp assembly to the wall, align the backplate (F) holes with the mounting screws on the mounting plate (BB), and secure the backplate assembly to the wall with the small finials (FF).



## 3 Assembling the shade

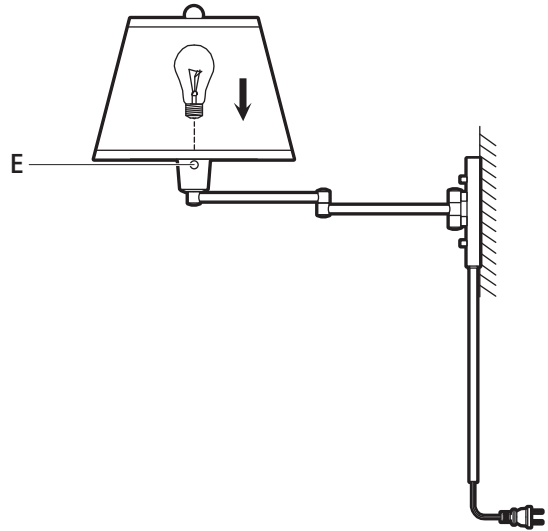
- Squeeze the legs of the harp (C) together and insert the two ends into the socket cover (D).
- Place the shade (B) onto the harp (C) and secure with the finial (A).



## Installation (continued)

### 4 Installing the bulb

- Prior to installing the bulb, inspect the socket for a silica packet. If the packet is present, remove and throw away. Do not expose it to children or pets.
- Install a 120V, 60HZ, 100-watt max. medium-base type A 3-way bulb (not included) in the socket of the lamp.
- Plug the cord into an outlet and turn on at the switch (E).



## Care and Cleaning

- Clean the light fixture with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use any cleaners with chemicals, solvents, or harsh abrasives.

## Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
The bulb will not light.	□ The bulb is burned out.	□ Replace the light bulb.
	□ The power is off.	□ Ensure that the power supply is turned on.
	□ There is a faulty wire connection.	□ Check the wiring.
	□ The circuit breaker is off.	□ Ensure that the circuit breaker is set to the On position.
The fuse blows or a circuit breaker trips when the light is turned on.	□ There is an exposed wire.	□ Discontinue use of the light fixture. □ Contact a qualified electrician or call the Customer Service Team at 1-855-HD-HAMPTON.
	□ There are too many items on one circuit.	□ Unplug other items on the circuit.
