- 1. Turn off power and install in accordance with local electrical codes.
- Thread lampholders into cover; coat threads with sealing compound (not included) and tighten.

- Wire the lampholder(s) to the supply lines in the box, white to white (neutral), black to black (hot) and green to green (ground).
