DIRECTIONS: 1. Sand paint, primer, dirt, and rotted wood from repair area. Remove dust created from sanding. 2. Brush on 4-6 coats of Bondo® Rotted Wood Restorer. Allow two minutes between coats for product to soak into wood. Gloves are recommended. 3. Allow the Restorer to dry for two hours. 4. Lightly scuff the dried surface with 3M™ Sandpaper. The surface is now ready for an application of Bondo® Wood Filler or Bondo® All-Purpose Putty to replace rotted or missing wood. If filling the area is not necessary, the surface can be primed and painted. 5. Clean the applicator brush with acetone or lacquer thinner.
