Safety Instructions

- **Weight Limit:** The table supports a maximum weight of 160 lbs. Avoid exceeding this limit to prevent damage—distribute weight evenly across the surface, especially when placing heavy serving dishes.
- **Stability:** Always position the table on a flat, level surface. Ensure the anti-slip foot pads are fully in contact with the ground to prevent tipping, even in windy conditions.
- **Umbrella Use:** When using an umbrella, secure it tightly through the umbrella hole to avoid instability. Remove the umbrella during strong winds to prevent strain on the table frame.
- **Assembly Caution:** Keep small hardware (screws, bolts) away from children during setup. Tighten all connections securely to ensure stability.

Assembly Guidelines

- **Included Items:** All necessary parts and tools are provided for assembly.
- **Steps:**
 - i. Lay out components on a clean, flat surface to verify completeness.
 - ii. Attach the table legs to the tabletop frame using the provided screws, tightening them evenly to avoid warping.
 - iii. Ensure the umbrella hole (if pre-drilled) is clear of debris.
 - iv. Check that the table is stable and level before use—adjust by tightening loose hardware if needed.

Usage Tips

- **Ideal Placement:** Perfect for outdoor dining areas, paired with compatible chairs (from the complete patio set) to seat up to 4 people. The round shape encourages easy conversation and movement.
- **Umbrella Compatibility:** Use an umbrella with a pole diameter that fits the table's umbrella hole (check product specifications for exact measurements) to ensure a secure fit.
- **Cushion Care:** If using included seat cushions, place them on chairs only during use. Store cushions indoors when not in use to preserve their all-weather fabric.

Cleaning & Maintenance

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Aluminum Frame & Tabletop:

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- Regularly wipe with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust and debris.
- For dirt or stains, clean with a solution of mild soap and warm water, using a soft sponge or cloth. Rinse thoroughly and dry with a towel to prevent water spots.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners, steel wool, or harsh chemicals (e.g., bleach), as they can damage the powder coating.

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Anti-Slip Foot Pads:

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- Inspect foot pads periodically for wear. If they become damaged or lose their grip, replace them with compatible PA66 nylon pads to maintain stability and protect surfaces.

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Umbrella Hole:

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- Keep the hole clear of dirt and debris. If not using an umbrella, insert a plug (if included) to prevent debris buildup.

Storage

- **Seasonal Storage:** If storing the table for extended periods (e.g., winter), clean it thoroughly first.
- **Stacking:** If paired with stackable chairs, stack chairs separately to save space. Store the table in a dry, covered area (e.g., garage, shed) to protect it from extreme weather.
- **Cushion Storage:** Store seat cushions in a dry, well-ventilated area. Avoid folding them to prevent creases in the fabric.

Troubleshooting

- **Wobbly Table:** Ensure the surface is level. Tighten loose screws on the legs or frame. If uneven, adjust by adding a small, flat pad under the shorter leg (avoid altering the foot pads).
- **Powder Coating Damage:** If the coating chips or scratches, touch up with a matching high-temperature-resistant spray paint designed for aluminum to prevent rust.
- **Stuck Umbrella Pole:** If the umbrella pole sticks in the hole, apply a small amount of silicone lubricant (avoid oil-based products) to loosen it.

By following these care steps, your cast aluminum patio dining table will remain a stylish and functional centerpiece of your outdoor space, providing years of enjoyment for meals, gatherings, and relaxation.
