THE NATURAL WAY TO WEATHER WOOD

STEP 1



**Prep** Prepare wood by sanding with 80 grit sandpaper.

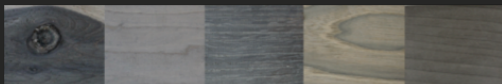
STEP 2



**Get Your Color**

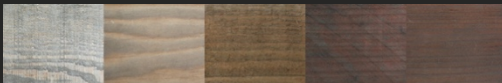
## STORM

For an authentic, extreme weathered wood look. Perfect for most wood types.



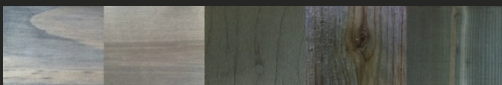
## MIST

For a light weathered wood look on mid-high tannin wood. Lighter & warmer colors than Storm.



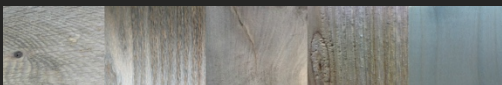
## PINED

Silvery gray on low tannin woods. Medium-to-dark gray on higher tannin wood.



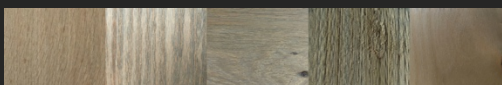
## OAKED

Beautiful silvery gray driftwood look on nearly all wood types.



## RUSTED

Beautiful light, warm brown look on nearly all wood types.



### DIRECTIONS:

APPLY SELECTED WOOD STAIN TO SANDED WOOD. ALLOW TO AIR DRY. DO NOT WIPE BACK OFF. TONE COLOR WITH MAINTENANCE OILS. PROTECT WOOD WITH TOPCOAT OF YOUR CHOICE.

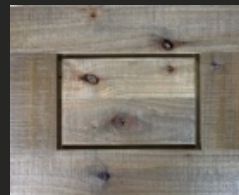
