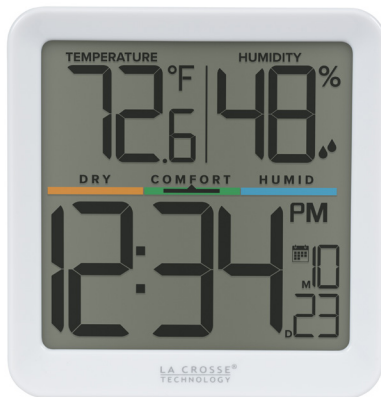

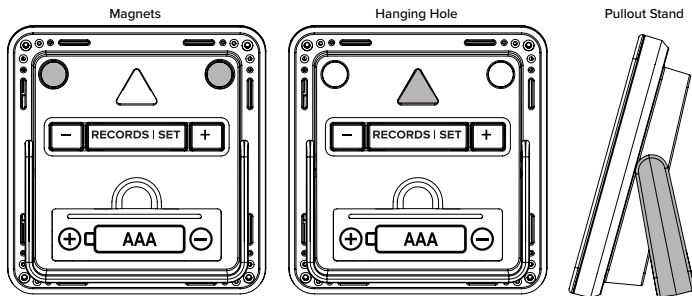
MODEL: 302-1408

Initial Setup

1. Insert 1-AAA battery into the Digital Clock.
2. Use the Settings Menu to set your time and date.

3. Versatile Placement

- Attach it to a magnetic surface using the built-in Magnets
- Hang it on a wall with the rear Hanging Hole
- Place it on a flat surface using the Pullout Stand.



Settings Menu

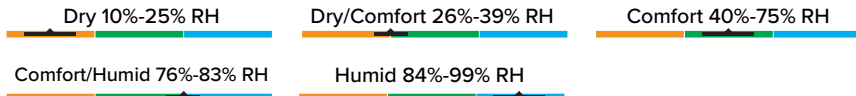
1. Hold the **RECORDS | SET** button until the display changes to enter the Settings Menu.
2. Press and release the **+** or **-** button to adjust values. Hold to adjust quickly.
3. Press and release the **RECORDS | SET** button to confirm values and move to the next setting or exit.

- 12/24 Hour Format
- Hour
- Minutes
- Year
- Month
- Date
- Fahrenheit/Celsius

Comfort Meter

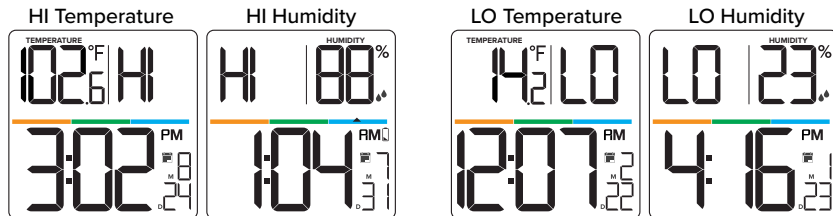
The Comfort Meter provides a visual indication of the humidity level in your home. The black arrow indicates the comfort level.



Temperature/Humidity Records

Press and release the **RECORDS | SET** button to view Hi and LO Temperature and Humidity Records with Time and Date.

Viewing Order: High Temperature, High Humidity, Low Temperature, Low Humidity



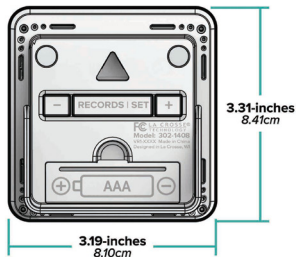
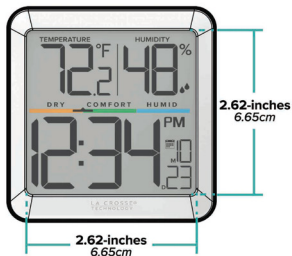
Reset Records:

1. Press and release the **RECORDS | SET** button to view records.
2. While viewing, hold the **- (MINUS)** button to reset individual records.

Care & Maintenance
